### Superintendent Presentation:

- Vote is December 13, 2022 @ 7am 9pm Amherst High School
- \$68 million dollar budget
- Rishawn Sonubi project architect
  - District leadership met with key faculty to develop the programmatic needs and wants
  - Building and Grounds conditions survey was conducted
  - Process to select the scope of the project
  - District Wide Safety and Security Enhancements: Main Entry renovation, add intrusion resistant film on doors and windows, PA system with silent alarm capabilities, add intrusion lock sets to all doors, additional security cameras, upgrade exterior lighting to LED
  - District Wide: Auditorium Upgrades, Heating and Ventilation, Stage Lighting, Stage Sound System, Stage Rigging, Renovation of High School of Auditorium
  - District Wide: MEP Systems Upgrades: building wide mechanical system replacements, upgrade unit ventilators, boiler system at HS and MS, R, new hot water heaters, chimney stack, elevator, IT equipment rooms, etc.
  - High School: South Gym: New Floor, lighting replacement, window replacement, locker rooms, vestibule, Replace HVAC equipment,
  - High School Site Work: Multi Sport Turf Fields, Field Lighting, Scoreboards, Bleachers, New Parking Lot, Teams Building with Toilet Rooms,
    - Questions:
      - Are these equitable fields? Yes that is the plan
      - Are these strictly for district use? The priority is for the district and will continue to work with current organizations that use the fields outside of the district
      - Community Use? Yes it will be open to the community for use like it is currently
      - Wraps on the walls in the South Gym? Hope to leave it or replace it, students love the branding, branding is important
      - Auditorium: Air Conditioning? Upgrading the Heating and Ventilation will be installed, priority was made to large spaces: Cafeteria at Windermere, Middle School, MPR in the High School

#### - Middle School Upgrades:

- Career and Life Rooms, Renovate Parent Pick Up and Drop Off to improve traffic flow
- Smallwood Elementary:
  - Upgrade the entry, new dividing partitions, loading dock, a/c in cafeteria, upgrade parent pick up and drop off, improve tennis/multisport courts,
- Windermere Elementary:
  - Early Childhood Center classrooms, 1 indoor play space, covered patio, Door closures, replace exterior doors, roof coverings, renovate tennis courts, renovate pick up drop off area

# Budget: Laura Bosinski

- 68.7 million Budget: 41% Facilities, 14% health safety welfare, 17% Educational space improvements, 28%
- 65% State Aide, 26% Local Share, 8% Reserves/Other Funds

### Schedule:

- Construction to start in the summer of 2024 ending 2027
- Phase I: Smallwood & Windermere
- Phase II: Middle School
- Phase III: High School

#### **Questions:**

- Turf/Field: Study on the impact to the neighbors? There was not a study done, lighting was talked about installing downward directional lighting, looking at having as much as a buffer as possible from the property line, and installing a walkway around the fields.
- Middle School Pool? There is a need, looked at expanding the pool up to the property line, 18\$ million to do this and only add a lane and some bleachers. This is on the list for a future project
- High School Auditorium Historical Guidelines? Yes the upgrades are in compliance
- Consistent fence? Not sure, depending on the design
- Communication: fliers going home, on the district website, social media
